Joust is a contemporary piece that looks back upon the days of Medieval jousting among the knights. Classical Bash is an arrangement of four famous melodies from the Classical era - Beethoven's Fifth Symphony, Haydn's Surprise Symphony, Mozart's Eine Kleine Nachtmusik, and Beethoven's Ninth Symphony, Ode to Joy theme.

The summer recital took place at 11:30 a.m. on Knott's Calico Square Stage in front of a crowd of parents, siblings, friends, and park-goers.
